Definition

1. FORM - The structure or shape of a musical work, based on repetition, contrast, and variation: the organizing principle in music.
2. D.C. al Coda - A navigation marking meaning to go back to the beginning and play to the coda sign, and then skip to the coda section.
3. UNISON - Two notes of the same pitch: voices that are all singing the same pitch.
4. CANTABILE - In a singing style
5. SOSTENUTO - Sustained singing, long, rather slow phrases the singer is capable of singing on one breath. One of the hallmarks of "bel canto" singing.
6. RUBATO - 'borrowed time' - a flexibility in tempo that allows the performer to speed up at some places and get slower in others.
7. PHRASE - Within a piece of music, a segment that is unified by rhythms, melodies, or harmonies and that comes to some sort of closure.
8. FERMATA - Symbol used to indicate that a note should be held indefinitely: sometimes called a bird's eye.
9. D.C. al Fine - Navigation marking meaning to go back to the beginning and play through to the Fine marking.
10. SOFT VOICE - In a soft voice.
